Can Endicott College rely solely on its endowment for funding?

The answer is "no", and it's important to understand how an endowment works to know why.

An endowment is a collection of invested capital, which includes endowed gifts. These gifts can only be used for purposes designated by the donor, and the College cannot withdraw funds from the endowment itself.

While the endowment provides a valuable source of funding at Endicott, earnings from the endowment alone cannot cover all operating costs. Endicott relies on a mix of current-use gifts and endowments to ensure that it can continue to provide its students with an exceptional education.
