Having just graduated in May with a degree in business management, I am proud to say, I am a Kean University alumnus! I was involved in many clubs and organizations and ended my tenure as Executive Board President of Student Organization. It was important to me to stay active with student affairs and involved with the Kean Community.

I am excited to announce some of last year's highlights. Kean University continues to be at the forefront of higher education and "Creating Opportunities."

- President Lamont O. Repollet, Ed.D., traveled across the South with 18 Kean students and others who are part of the Human Rights Institute (HRI). During the Civil Rights Journey, they walked through history with guides who experienced the fight for equality themselves, and whose stories are a testament to the principles of equity, justice and inclusivity that are core values for our University. This year, the HRI group will travel to Northern Ireland to see how the American civil rights movement influenced that part of the world;
- Kean University became the state's first urban research university, recognizing Kean's growing role in conducting research and generating solutions to issues in urban communities statewide;
- The University made improvements to many of its athletic facilities, including Harwood Arena, the track at Alumni Stadium, baseball and softball fields, the addition of a new esports arena, and more;
- Six Kean STEM students received awards at the Great Minds in STEM Virtual Conference, including one student who won the conference hackathon competition;
- The School of Communication, Media and Journalism launched a new certification program
  that will qualify Kean students to lead conversations on diversity and equity both inside and
  outside the classroom;
- Kean has been designated as a National Center of Academic Excellence in Cyber Defense by the National Security Agency for its academic programs and practices to address a growing national crisis;

- The University has been recognized as a First-gen Forward institution by the Center for First-generation Student Success for its support and advancement of students who are the first in their families to attend college;
- The postdoctoral fellowship program is enhancing the University's standing as one of the most diverse universities in the nation by attracting postgraduate students from all backgrounds to teach and conduct research at Kean.
- Kean has been named a Professional/Doctoral University by the Carnegie Commission on Higher Education, reflecting the University's increased number of doctoral programs offered and degrees awarded, as well as Kean's strong commitment to research; and,
- Two graduating business students will head into the future with resumes boosted by a strong showing at an international stock trading competition conducted by Bloomberg L.P. They were members of a team from Kean that placed in the top 5% out of nearly 500 teams from the United States and around the world in the Bloomberg Global Trading Challenge.
