## Requirements:

The minimum gift amount required to fund these scholarships is \$1,000 per year (\$4,000 over four years), but larger amounts are certainly welcome.

**Donors with pledges signed and first payments made between now and June 30 will have their scholarship awarded and will be connected with their student in the fall semester.**
