



## **EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION:**

With over 1,900 full-time faculty members and more than 9,000 Einstein alumni counted among the nation's foremost clinicians, biomedical scientists and medical educators, Einstein offers one of the nation's largest programs for medical education. Today, the College of Medicine is home to over 1,050 M.D. or doctoral students, and 255 postdoctoral research fellows.

## **RENOWNED FOR RESEARCH:**

Long a national leader in biomedical research support from the Federal government, Einstein received more than \$202 million in funding from the National Institutes of Health during 2022. This includes the funding for major research centers at Einstein in aging, intellectual development disorders, diabetes, cancer, clinical and translational research, liver disease and AIDS. Other areas of focus include developmental brain research, neuroscience, cardiac disease, and initiatives to reduce and eliminate ethnic and racial health disparities.
