### OUR ELECTION TO APSIA HAS BEEN 10 YEARS IN THE MAKING:

#### 2011

FIU School of International & Public Affairs opens its first building with 58,000 SF of space.

#### 2015

In recognition of a \$20 million gift from the Green Family, the School is renamed the **Steven J. Green School of International & Public Affairs**, and the founding dean, the late **John F. Stack Jr.**, initiates efforts to gain full APSIA membership.

#### 2017

FIU Trustee **Carlos Trujillo** and Green School alumna and State Senator **Anitere Flores '97** are instrumental in advocating for funding from the Florida Legislature for a second Green School building, helping the Green School's application for full APSIA membership.

#### 2021

The Green School becomes a full member of APSIA, one of only 38 schools in the world (along with Stanford, Princeton, and Georgetown, among others) and the only one in Florida.

#### 2022

*U.S. News & World Report* ranks the Green School graduate program in global policy and administration No. 3 among public universities. Five other Green School graduate programs are ranked in the top 50 among public institutions.

#### 2023

The a new Green School building is set to open with 85,000 SF of space.
