RESPONSIBILITIES

- Managing production schedules for webinars, workshops, podcasts, meetings, and other activities, and making sure that key stakeholders are completing required tasks accurately and on time.
- Producing and editing video, audio, and written content for a variety of platforms and programs.
- Coordinating pre-event tasks, including recruiting and onboarding instructors and guests, scheduling meetings, preparing content and agendas, updating technology platforms, communicating with contractors, vendors and venues, and developing content and materials.
- Develop materials and content for events (slide decks, worksheets, templates, samples)
- Providing technical and logistical support during live events.
- Carrying out post-event tasks, including collecting and filing assets and materials, editing audio and video recordings, updating technology platforms, sending out communications, following up with contractors, colleagues, vendors, and venues, and tracking feedback and metrics.

Must be highly organized and detail-oriented with strong writing and communication skills, a sense of humor, and a willingness to be flexible and patient in the context of a small and growing business.
